Independent Schools Inspectorate (ISI): Regulatory Compliance Report

I am delighted to share with you the attached ISI Regulatory Compliance Report.

We are extremely pleased with the report, which finds that we have met the rigorous standards in all eight categories.

The new ISI Inspection Framework falls in to 2 different types of inspection:-

- Regulatory Compliance
- Focused Compliance and Educational Quality

Our inspection was a Regulatory Compliance Inspection, and this means that the ISI Report makes clear whether, as a school, we have met or did not meet the ISSR (Independent Schools Standards Regulations) and the Early Years Foundation (EYFS) requirements.

In the New Framework Report there are no overall headline judgements “of Good, Excellent etc” on the quality of education provided by the School, findings are instead only focused on the extent to which the school has met the minimum standards laid out in the regulatory requirements outlined by the Department for Education.

The Regulatory Compliance Inspection conducted a very in-depth examination of the following 8 standards:-

- Quality of Education Provided - **Met the required standard**
- SMSC (Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural) development of pupils- **Met the required standard**
- Welfare, Health and Safety of pupils- **Met the required standard**
- Suitability of Staff, Supply Staff and Proprietors- **Met the required standard**
- Premises of and Accommodation at school- **Met the required standard**
- Provision of Information - **Met the required standard**
- The Manner in which Complaints are handled - **Met the required standard**
- Quality of Leadership in and Management of school - **Met the required standard**

For each of these 8 standards the Quality Compliance Report simply states whether, as a school, we have met each of the standards or not and then will give a brief factual statement which describes the standard.

We are extremely pleased with the outcome of the Inspection and welcome the opportunity to receive professional feedback on what we do well and how we can be even better moving the school forward in preparation for our Focus Compliance and Educational Quality Inspection in 2020.
