PE Kit & Tracksuit

As our school year is coming to an end I would like to remind you about PE kit in preparation for our new school year in September.

In September all students from Year 3-13 will be playing Hockey, Netball, Football and Rugby. Whilst it will be non-contact rugby from Years 3-6, when a gum shield is not compulsory, we will also be playing hockey across all school years and would therefore like all students from Years 3-13 to wear a gum shield.

Gum shields are available from the School Office for £2.00 or alternatively most good sports shops sell them. Please can you label your child's gum shield box and be aware how important it is to keep the box and the gum shield clean to avoid germs and possible infection.

I would also like to remind you that all students are required to wear the correct PE kit during Games and PE lessons (details are online at www.djuniforms.co.uk). This includes a full Webber tracksuit that is compulsory for all students in Years 3-13. This must be worn during lessons in the cold weather as well as looking smart when attending fixtures against other schools. If students would like to wear a base layer (a 'skin') when the weather becomes colder please can you ensure that it is a plain black one.

Please can you ensure that all items of kit are clearly marked with your child's name? We will be carrying out a kit check during the first week back to avoid the huge amount of unnamed PE items that end up in lost property each term.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for all your support during the past year, especially to those parents who have been collecting their children from matches as well as giving our children side line match encouragement. Once again we have had many fixtures this term resulting in some fantastic achievements by our enthusiastic and talented athletes.

I am looking forward to your children participating in lots more events next term, including Football, Netball, Hockey, Basketball and Badminton fixtures plus many more.
