Little Lives Charity

We have been supporting the Little Lives charity over the last six years and our Year 11-13 students chose this charity again this year to raise funds whilst raising money for their Prom.

The Little Lives Appeal is one of Milton Keynes Hospital's Charities which supports premature babies and their families. Donations to the Little Lives Appeal are spent on state-of-the-art medical equipment and other items that enhance the care of their tiniest patients. It's important the hospital keep up to date with the latest advances; babies need careful monitoring and support with expensive equipment so that they have the best chance of recovery.

Any equipment they purchase will help them care for their little patients. The length of stay for these babies can vary dramatically – from a few hours, to many months – but they will always care for them until they are ready to go home.

The Year 11-13 students will have the opportunity to visit the unit to help them understand the difference they make to these tiny people and their families.

This year we will begin our fundraising with the "Bag 2 School" scheme which is an organization that collects unwanted textiles: good quality second hand adults' and children's clothing, soft toys, paired shoes, jewellery, lingerie, hats, belts and handbags. All items collected are for **RE-USE**.
